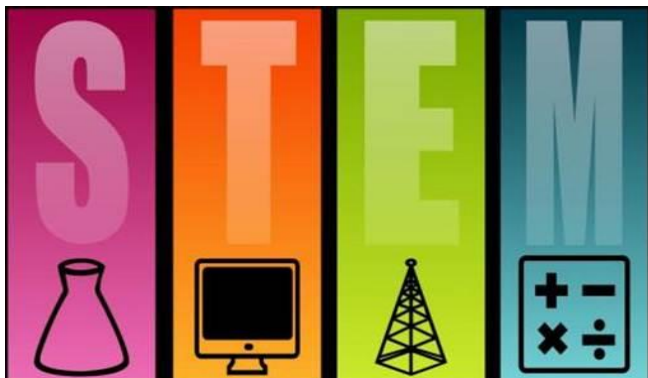

STEM/SCIENCE WEEK: The week beginning Monday, 15 May will be Beckley School Science/STEM week. During this time the focus will be on science and scientific enquiry.

The major event of the week will be **'Blast Science'** Day.

The day will include a show in the morning and a workshop for each class in the afternoon. The theme will be 'Forces'. *'What goes up must come down to what we know about Forces and Physics.'*

This science show creates the great big PUSH AND PULL needed to fire UP children about the heavy gravity of learning! Using plenty of audience participation, interactive live experiments, jaw-dropping terror, and lashings of comedy - this show is an eye opener to earthlings!

EVERGREEN - SCIENCE WORKSHOPS:

As part of the Rye College Science Outreach programme, Evergreen class have been invited to attend a series of science shows. These are designed to coincide with and enhance the National Curriculum. Each show combines elements of observing over a (short) time, identifying and classifying, comparative and fair testing and patterns and relationships. Most of the workshops will take place at Rye College where pupils will have the opportunity to engage in a range of activities, mainly demonstrations and experiments, in a safe and controlled environment. They will learn through doing and by having fun! The sessions at Rye College in Term 5 will take place on Friday 12 / Wednesday 17 / Friday 19 May.



On these days children should be dropped directly at Rye College by 8.45am. Minibuses will bring the children back to Beckley later in the morning.
