### Key Stage 2:

### Scaled Scores at Key Stage 2

A pupil's scaled score is based on their raw score. The raw score is the total number of marks a pupil scores in a test, based on the number of questions they answered correctly.	<b>104</b>	<b>101</b>

The scaled scores, for both reading and maths, are above the national average when based on prior attainment.

### Progress Scores from Key Stage 1 to Key Stage 2:
