BLUE SPRUCE - SMUGGLERS CAVES, HASTINGS:

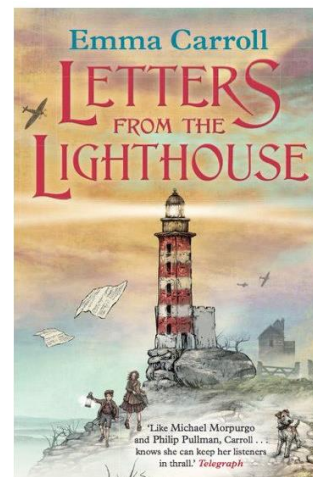
