Baguettes will be served with fresh side salad or vegetables of the day & dessert

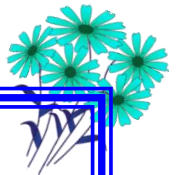


**Summer Fair: Saturday 6 July, 12-3pm**
