

Instructions for using PurpleMash for home learning

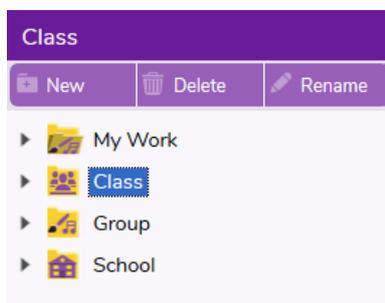
Over the coming weeks, we will be using Purple Mash to upload resources for the children and setting activities.

Work folders

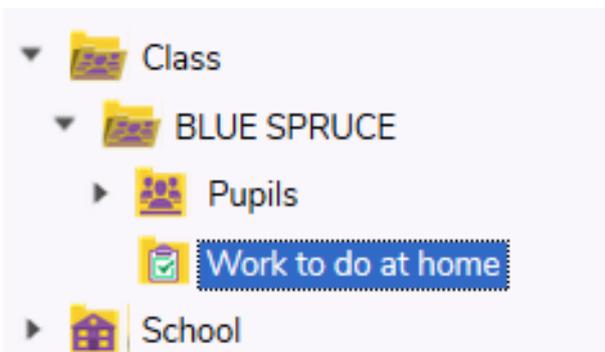
Each week's learning will be added to the Class 'Work to do at home' folder.



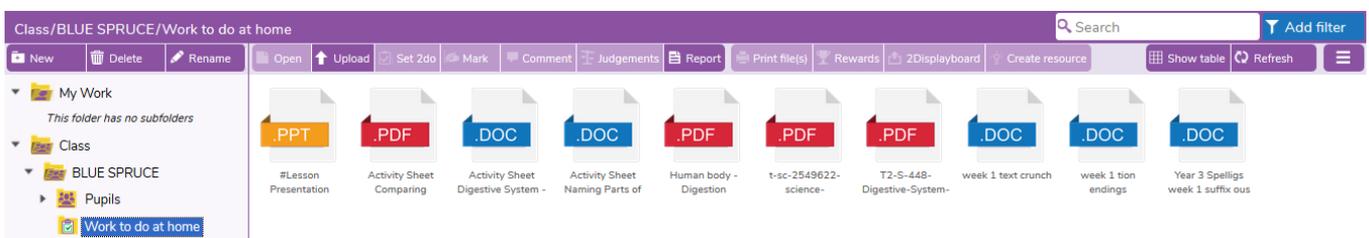
Click on 'Work'



Next, click on the black arrow next to 'class' and again next to 'BLUESPRUCE'.



Now, click on 'Work to do at home'.



Here you will see all the relevant resources for the week. Double click on the icons and they will download or open a new page.

Class Blogs

We have also set up class blogs, which will enable to children to share some of their learning by commenting directly or attaching photos or documents.

I have created Blue Spruce Blogs for different areas of learning and copies of all learning resources can also be found here. All blog posts have to be approved by a teacher before they are posted on to the page and they are only visible by the other members in the class.



Click on 'Sharing'.



Next, click on 'Shared Blogs'.

There are Blogs for different areas of Blue Spruce's learning.

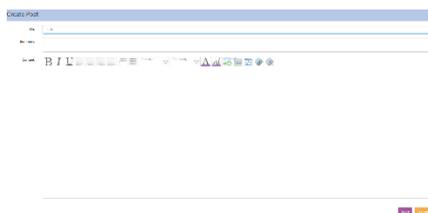
Click on links within each Blog to explore the learning. Pupils can type comments in these comment boxes.



Blogs with the green add symbol allow you to share your work on them as well.



To add something, click on the green add symbol.



Here you can type your learning inside the box, or upload an image of the learning you have done.

Blue Spruce Display Board
