Look at the symbols for Chinese Numbers. Write some number sentences using them.	Research some Chinese landmarks (like the Great Wall, Terracotta Warrior Army). Write a postcard as if you had just been to see it.	Research the different animals of the Chinese Zodiac. Find out which one you are (and other members of your family as well). What characteristics does it have, and is that similar to you?	Create your own Chinese Dragon! Look at real examples from China for inspiration. You can use junk modelling, LEGO etc. (if the model is not sturdy enough to be brought in, please take photos and email them in so you can show to the class)
Practise telling the time. Read the time to o'clock, half past, quarter past and quarter to. CHALLENGE! Can you read the clock to the nearest 5 minutes?	Research how rice is grown in China. Present your findings as either a poster, or on 'Powerpoint' and email it to school to show in class at the end of term.	Find out about Pandas, which are found in the rainforests in China. Create an information leaflet about them, and how and why we should try to save them from extinction.	Investigate Chinese Shadow puppets. Create some of your own to retell a story of your choice.
