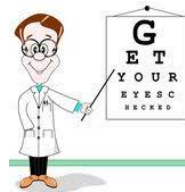

They will also need sensible footwear, suitable clothing for weather on the day (ie, lightweight waterproofs if wet and gloves if cold) and of course sun cream to protect from sunburn. The aim is to encourage and inspire children to use their bikes more, making safe trips on the road to school or for leisure. Thank you to the BSA who are funding this. The sessions will take place from 10am-12 noon and 1.15-3.15pm on Monday-Thursday. Please do bear this in mind when driving to school to collect children in the afternoon as some of the participating children may well be out on the road at that time.
